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INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING OVER THE INTERNET

For your convenience, online entry is available for all departments. Fee payments for online entries must be made by credit card. You must have entries in the show in order to purchase exhibitor tickets.

Please read all the rules in the premium book that apply to your department. All deadlines outlined in this document will be enforced for online entries.

If you submit an entry online, you do not need to mail or fax the same entry.

We are available to answer any questions you have at entry@kyvenues.com or (502) 367-5190.

Due to high volume, it may be difficult to locate your entry until it is completely processed and filed.

PRIVACY NOTICE

Your privacy and security are our highest priority. Ensuring electronic access to state government information and services while maintaining privacy is a guiding principle of the state's Strategic Information Technology Plan. The Kentucky State Fair Board collects only the personal information necessary to provide enhanced services to our visitors. Personal data in our possession is maintained and used in ways that respect individual privacy. The Kentucky State Fair Board educates employees about the importance of protecting personal information and consumer privacy, and only authorized employees have access to personal information.

Depending on the situation, we may collect the following information about visitors to our website:

the domain name, but not the e-mail address.
the e-mail address of those who communicate with us via e-mail
aggregate information about which pages consumers access or visit
information volunteered by the consumer

INFORMATION SHARING

The Kentucky State Fair Board will not provide, rent or sell personal information to third parties for marketing programs or any other purpose. State law restricts the use of personally identifiable information for commercial purposes.

EXHIBITOR TICKETS

Exhibitor tickets are offered to anyone who enters the competitive departments (General, Livestock & PPR). Exhibitor tickets come in a book of eleven (11) tickets. Each ticket includes admission and parking for the Kentucky State Fair. **Example:** If a family of four purchased and picked up a book of exhibitor tickets, they should give the gate attendant four (4) tickets and this will cover admission and parking. Exhibitors may only purchase **Two (2) books** of tickets unless they are caring for livestock.

Poultry, Pigeon and Rabbit exhibitors are limited to purchasing only two (2) books of tickets.

Exhibitor tickets may be picked up or purchased starting Saturday, August 10th, in the South Wing A Lobby. **Exhibitor tickets must be picked by Wednesday, August 14th at 5:00 p.m.** Once the Fair starts, everyone must present an exhibitor ticket or pay regular admission price and parking.

Exhibitor Tickets can be picked up or purchased on the following dates at the times and locations listed:

Saturday, August 10th – 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – South Wing A Lobby
Sunday, August 11th – 12:00 p.m. (Noon) to 5:00 p.m. – South Wing A Lobby
August 12th - 14th – 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. – Guest Services inside Freedom Hall

On Monday, August 12th, Culinary exhibitors may pick up or purchase exhibitor tickets at the Guest Services window located inside the front of Freedom Hall, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Exhibitor tickets must be purchased by August 14th.
No Exhibitor Ticket will be sold after Wednesday, August 14th.

The only pre-purchased tickets that will be mailed with entry tags are exhibitors in the Vegetables and Melons Senior Citizen Division and Plants and Flowers Rose Show exhibitors. All other tickets must be picked up at one of the times listed above.

Homebrew Beer exhibitor tickets will be available for pick up or purchase Wednesday, August 7th, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the kiosk booth near the Homebrew Department.

Homemade Wine exhibitors can pick up or purchase exhibitor tickets at the kiosk booth near the Homemade Wine Department on Thursday, August 8th and Friday, August 9th, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
