EAST HALL/SOUTH WING
GENERAL RULES

1. See General Rules and Regulations of the Kentucky State Fair. Any exhibitor failing to comply with any of the general rules or rules applying to their department will forfeit all premiums won.
2. Please read complete rules for each department you are planning to enter.
3. All entries must be made on official State Fair entry forms for these departments and postmarked by July 1. Entry fee must accompany entry form. To enter online, go to www.kystatefair.org. Complete information must be provided.
4. Entry Fee: \$15.00 per exhibitor, all entries made in any departments (except Homebrew Beer) For Example: An exhibitor can enter one (1) item in Fine Arts and two (2) items in Textiles and it will cost \$15.00. Entries must be postmarked by July 1 or a late fee will be charged.

Homebrew Beer - \$5.00 per beer entry fee.
Entries must be postmarked by July 1.

NOTE: Please see Homebrew Beer and Homemade Wine sections in regards to age restrictions.

LATE ENTRIES: An entry fee of \$20 per exhibitor will be charged for all entries postmarked after July 1. Late entry forms must be received by July 10. No entries will be accepted after that date.

Homebrew Beer - \$8.00 per beer late entry fee.

Late entry forms must be received by July 10.

- 5. Entry acceptance times are strictly enforced. Exhibitors MUST have their entries in the correct department by the ending time listed for their entries to be accepted.**
- 6. All times listed are Eastern Standard Time (EST).**
- 7. Entry tags will be mailed out to exhibitors from the Kentucky State Fair Entry Department, no later than July 29th. The exhibitor should place these entry tags on the proper articles. Each exhibitor should retain 'Claim Check' part of entry tag to identify and reclaim article at close of the Fair. NOTE: Read individual department rules in regards to specific placement of tags on entries.**
- 8. These exhibits will be located in South Wing or East Hall. No exhibitor will be allowed in departments during the judging.**
- 9. Entries will be released on Monday, August 26. Any entry not claimed by 7:00 p.m. will be properly disposed of by the Kentucky State Fair. Please see specific release times in each department. Please note rules in each department relating to disposal of items.**
- 10. Exhibitors outside the Louisville vicinity may ship entries, postage prepaid, to the Entry Department, Kentucky State Fair, 937 Phillips Lane, Louisville, KY 40209. Entry tags and exhibitor information should be included in package. Shipped articles will not be accepted before Wednesday, July 31 and must arrive no later than Wednesday, August 7. NOTE: Some departments have**

specific shipping/packaging requirements, please read department rules carefully.

In a partnership, the Kentucky Department of Agriculture (KDA), the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Services and the Kentucky State Fair are teaming up to deliver selected agriculture and non-ag general department exhibits. 11. All entries (outside Louisville and vicinity) not called for will be repacked and returned to the exhibitor at the exhibitor's expense and risk. The Kentucky State Fair assumes no responsibility for any item that may be damaged or lost. Parcels will be sent C.O.D. Exhibitors living in Louisville and vicinity must pick up their exhibits as they will not be mailed.
12. The Management will not be responsible for any article exhibited, but due care and diligence will be given in handling of entries and guards will be furnished to give reasonable protection to exhibits at all times.
13. Once the Fair opens, exhibitors must pay admission or present an exhibitor ticket. Exhibitors admission tickets may be purchased from the Entry Department. Exhibitors will be limited to the purchase of two exhibitor books.
14. All entries in all departments will be displayed at the discretion of the Kentucky State Fair management. The Kentucky State Fair Board, in its sole discretion, may decline the acceptance of any entry that it deems not suitable for display or exhibit at the Kentucky State Fair.
